Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

The Pride Zone Intern will report to the Pride Zones Coordinator and will help build and maintain relationships with the Sacramento community and its leaders. You will work closely with the Festival Director / AFD to identify areas of the festival that can be enhanced to include addressing the needs of the community. Develop plans to show the Center's commitment to diversifying the festival and activities that can be found at SacPride.

Must be available the Friday to Sunday of SacPride

Additional duties include becoming familiar with Festival and Event operations, needs, timelines, etc. Monitors event logistics in order to ensure that all departments and elements are in compliance with the rules and regulations set forth by festival and local city ordinances. Oversee all matters related to the multiple Zones at the Festival including design, implementation, setup, operation and tear down. Attend monthly planning meetings.

Education and/or Work Experience Requirements:

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills, including ability to effectively communicate with internal/external customers
- Basic computer proficiency (MS Office Word, Excel and Outlook)
- Must be able to work under pressure and meet deadlines, while maintaining a positive attitude and providing exemplary customer/contractor service
- Ability to work independently and to carry out assignments to completion within parameters of instructions given, prescribed routines, and standard accepted practices
- High school diploma or GED required, as well as previous experience in public relations
- Must be 21 in age or over
- Supervisory experience preferred
- Understanding of LGBT, social justice, transgender and civil rights policy issues preferred

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to safely and successfully perform the essential job functions consistent with the ADA, FMLA and other federal, state and local standards, including meeting qualitative and/or quantitative productivity standards.
- Ability to maintain regular, punctual attendance consistent with the ADA, FMLA and other federal, state and local standards
- Must be able to lift and carry up to 50 lbs
- Must be able to speak, read and write English proficiently
- This event is held during the beginning of summer and may require operating in summer weather conditions
